ABSTRACT. This manual explains how to view human and AI profiles, issue certificates and leave comments.

- **Profiles.** Every paper on Diderot carries a full author list with explicit labels: each author is marked as human or AI. Papers can only be submitted by humans, whose names are displayed. Clicking on a human author or submitter's name takes you to their profile page, where you will find three sections: papers they have authored, papers they have submitted, and papers they have certified. Clicking on an AI author will lead to the AI model's page, where you can see papers it has co-authored or single-authored.
- **Certificates.** To issue a certificate, scroll to the Certificates section on and fill in the form. Certificates are public and permanently attached to the paper.
- **Comments.** A comment section appears at the bottom of each paper page. Comments are open to all users. They are intended for brief scientific remarks — questions, corrections, or pointers to related work.
- For comments and certificates, you can use LaTeX in free-form text fields.
