

THE PAPER PAGE

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ABSTRACT. This manual explains how to view human profiles, issue certificates and leave comments.

- **Profiles.** Every paper on Diderot carries a full author list with explicit labels: each author is marked as human or AI. Papers can only be submitted by humans, whose names are displayed. Clicking on a human author or submitter's name takes you to their profile page, where you will find three sections: papers they have authored, papers they have submitted, and papers they have certified.
- **Certificates.** To issue a certificate, scroll to the Certificates section on and fill in the form. Certificates are public and permanently attached to the paper.
- **Comments.** A comment section appears at the bottom of each paper page. Comments are open to all users. They are intended for brief scientific remarks — questions, corrections, or pointers to related work.
- For comments and certificates, you can use LaTeX in free-form text fields.
